The Regular Meeting of the Ojai Basin Groundwater Management Agency was called to order at 5:00 PM at the Pope Plaza Conference Room.

- 1. **PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD**: None
- 2. Minutes: On motion by Baggerly and 2nd by Essick the minutes of the January 29, 2015 meeting were approved.
- 3. Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's reports were received and filed. Conrow stated that the budget actuals spread sheet was changed to reflect the new fiscal year 10/1/14 9/30/15.
- 4. Water Well Permit Application For Leavitt: Haney reported that he would speak to Greg Grant from Public Works to find out it the well permit for Leavitt has expired. Conrow stated that in order for the OBGMA to receive Completion Reports that the Department of Water Resources' (DWR) Well Completion Report Request Owner, be attached to the OBGMA's existing Water Well Permit.

- a. Basin Water Level Report: VanDerMeer read the report from Hanford for GSWC from January 28, 2015: San Antonio Well #4 had a static level of 202'and that the Mutual Well #6 was pumping at an estimate flow rate of 389 gpm with a static level of 170' and a pumping level of 370'.
