The Regular Meeting of the Ojai Basin Groundwater Management Agency was called to order at 5:00 PM at the Pope Plaza Conference Room.

- 1. **PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD:** No public comments were received.
- 2. Minutes: On motion by Leach and 2nd by Bergen the minutes of the April 25, 2013 meeting were approved.
- 3. **Treasurer's Report:** The Treasurer's reports were received and filed. The Board requested VanDerMeer to adjust the layout of the Budget spreadsheet to fit on one page.
- 4. 2013/2014 Budget: The Board approved the 2013/2014 Budget unanimously.
- 5. **Resolution 2013-1Noncompliant well owners:** Clapp suggested that the declared abandoned be changed July 31, 2013. b. Basin Water Level Report: Petersen reported that the San Antonio Well #4 was pumping at 195 gpm with a pump level of 407'. The state level of Well #1 was 138'.
